Happiness and Prosperity



HEALTH

Health was earlier said to be the ability of the body functioning well. However, as time evolved, the definition of health also evolved. It cannot be stressed enough that health is the primary thing after which everything else follows. When you maintain good health, everything else falls into place. Similarly, maintaining good health is dependent on a lot of factors. It ranges from the air you breathe to the type of people you choose to spend your time with. Health has a lot of components that carry equal importance. If even one of them is missing, a person cannot be completely healthy.

Constituents of Good Health

First, we have our physical health. This means being fit physically and in the absence of any kind of disease or illness. When you have good physical health, you will have a longer life span. One may maintain their physical health by having a balanced diet. Do not miss out on the essential nutrients; take each of them in appropriate quantities. Secondly, you must exercise daily. It may be for ten minutes only but never miss it. It will help your body maintain physical fitness. Moreover, do not consume junk food all the time. Do not smoke or drink as it has serious harmful consequences. Lastly, try to take adequate sleep regularly instead of using your phone. Next, we talk about our mental health. Mental health refers to the psychological and emotional well-being of a person. The mental health of a person impacts their feelings and way of handling situations. We must maintain our mental health by being positive and meditating. Subsequently, social health and cognitive health are equally important for the overall well-being of a person. A person can maintain their social health when they effectively communicate well with others. Moreover, when a person us friendly and attends social gatherings, he will definitely have good social health. Similarly, our cognitive health refers to performing mental processes effectively. To do that well, one must always eat healthily and play brain games like Chess, puzzles and more to sharpen the brain. Physical Health Alone is Not Everything There is this stigma that surrounds mental health. People do not take mental illnesses seriously. To be completely fit, one must also be mentally fit. When people completely discredit mental illnesses, it creates a negative impact. For instance, you never tell a person with cancer to get over it and that it's all in their head in comparison to someone dealing with depression. Similarly, we should treat mental health the same as physical health. Parents always take care of their children's physical needs. They feed them with nutritious foods and always dress up their wounds immediately. However, they fail to notice the deteriorating mental health of their child. Mostly so, because they do not give it that much importance. It is due to a

lack of awareness amongst people. Even amongst adults, you never know what a person is going through mentally.

Thus, we need to be able to recognize the signs of <u>mental illnesses</u>. A laughing person does not equal a happy person. We must not consider mental illnesses as a taboo and give it the attention it deserves to save people's lives.

UNDERSTANDING HARMONY IN NATURE

Nature as Collection of Units

Nature is the collection of all the units – the air, soil, water, plants, trees, animals, birds, other human beings and even things that are at a distant from us like the sun, the moon, the other planets, etc.

Classification of Units into Four Orders

Although the units are innumerable, they can all be classified into just four orders:

- 1. Physical order this includes units like air, water, metal and so on.
- 2. Bio order this includes grass, plants, trees, etc.
- 3. Animal order this includes animals and birds.
- 4. Human order this has human being only.

Harmony among the Four Orders

There is mutual fulfilment among the first three orders in nature. The soil-plant interaction is an example of mutual fulfilment between the physical order and the bio order. Animals and birds (units of the animal order) depend on plants (units of the bio order) for their food. At the same time, animals and birds help to spread the seeds of plants from one place to the other. They protect plants from harmful insects and pests. Similarly, the units of physical order, like air and water, are essential for animals to survive. In turn, animals enrich the soil – their dung and their dead bodies act as very good manure which makes the soil fertile. This is amply visible in the forests. These three orders are enriching for the human being too. This we can see from our day to day life. Now, is the human being fulfilling for the other three orders? This is a big question. Human being is not only unfulfilling for the other three orders, rather it is dominating and exploiting them, to the extent of global warming and climate change. Once human beings understand the mutual fulfillment among the four orders, they can be fulfilling for all the orders.

Interconnectedness, Self-regulation and Mutual Fulfilment among the Four Orders of Nature

With the above discussion, we can conclude that there is interconnectedness and mutual fulfilment among the four orders in nature. One can also see that there is self-regulation in

nature. In a forest, the proportion of soil, plants and animals of various species is self-regulated. It never happens that the lions eat up all the deer or the deer eat up all the grasses or that the plants grow to the extent that there is no space for deer or that there is lack of soil for new plants and so on. The forest does not need to be regulated by human being to be in harmony. With right understanding only, human being will also be self-organised, in harmony within and participate in the harmony in the larger order.

Abundance in Nature

Nature is organised in such a manner that the physical facility required for any order is available in abundance. The quantity of soil is far more than that of plants and trees. And both of these are available in far greater quantities as compared to the quantity of animals and birds. Human beings require all these three orders to survive, and the quantity of all these three orders together is far more than the quantity of human beings.

RELATIONSHIP

Relationship is between the self (I) and the other self (I). There are nine feelings (values), or expectation of feelings (values), in relationship: of oneself (I) for the other self (I). These feelings (values) can be recognized: they are definite (**9 Feelings**), their fulfilment and evaluation leads to mutual happiness.

Trust or vishwas is the foundational value in relationship. "To be assured that each human being inherently wants oneself and the other to be happy and prosperous" is known as trust. Having faith in others and believing them. **Respect** means individuality. The sense of

individuality is prime object. This is the first basic step towards respect (sammana). Once we realized that we are individual then only we can see our self different from others. In other words, respect means right evaluation, to be evaluated as I am. **Affection** is the feeling of being related to the other. The feeling of affection comes only if trust and respect are already ensured.

The feeling of **care** is the feeling to nurture and protect the body of our relative. Or in other words a state of mind in which one is troubled; worry, anxiety, or concern is called care. Care is level of active concern, or lack of negligence, towards avoidance of possible dangers, mistakes, pitfalls, and risks, demanded of a party as a duty or legal obligation. The feeling of ensuring right understanding and feelings in the other (my relative) is called **guidance**. The feeling of acceptance of excellence in the other is called **reverence**. We understand that we aspire for continuous happiness and to realize it, we have to understand harmony at all the levels of our living, and live accordingly.

Glory is the feeling for someone who has made efforts for excellence. Gratitude is the feeling of acceptance for those who have made efforts for my excellence. Gratitude is an emotion that occurs after people receive help, depending on how they interpret the situation. Love is the principle which creates and sustains human relations with dignity and depth. Love means I can be kind, caring and understanding. Love is the basis for a belief in equality and good will toward all.

Justice is the recognition of values (the definite feelings) in relationship, their fulfilment, the right evaluation of the fulfilment resulting in mutual happiness. Once we have recognized the existence of human relationship, we are subsequently able to identify the feelings (values). Thus there are four elements of ensuring values in relationship: recognition of values, fulfilment, evaluation and mutual happiness ensured. When all the four are ensured justice is ensured.

UNIVERSAL HUMAN VALUES -SELF MANAGEMENT-PEER PRESSURE

Self-management, which is also referred to as "self-control" or "self-regulation," is the ability to regulate one's emotions, thoughts, and behaviours effectively in different situations in a productive way. Self-management skills include setting a personal goal to ensure that you stay focused on your long-term objective and not just what is happening at the moment. The purpose of setting personal goals is to have some measure against which you can assess themselves. Self-management skills boost their productivity and performance at work, which helps in achieving professional goals. It is a soft skill that increases your employability and gives you more control over your career path. Students are motivated for are the biggest self-management skills such as

effective time management and prioritization, confident decision-making, graceful stress management, and strong problem solving students are encouraged for team building activities.

Self-awareness lies at the heart of the ability to master one-self. Developing self-control and clarifying priorities and goals help individual creates direction in their own lives. Managing time and stress make it possible for individuals to adapt to and organize surroundings. It gives us the power to influence outcomes. It helps us to become better decision-makers It gives us more self-confidence so, as a result, we communicate with clarity and intention. It allows us to understand things from multiple perspectives. It frees us from our assumptions and biases. It helps us build better relationships. It gives us a emotions. It decreases stress. It makes us happier. Students are motivated for self-management and self-awareness related activities are conducted by forming student peer groups.

Peer pressure or influence is when you do something because you want to feel accepted and valued by your friends. Peer influence can be positive or negative. Coping well with peer influence is about getting the right balance between being yourself and fitting in with your group. Peer Relationship Problems occur when students have trouble cooperating with others and have trouble making friends. Peer relationship problems can lead to friendships with peers who make poor choices, an inability to maintain quality friendships, being bullied, and later development of internalizing concerns.

Peer pressure is commonly thought of in a negative light, but in reality, it's not always a bad thing. 


STORYTELLING (THEME BASED)
